3. The Plaintiff's case was dismissed without even being address by the Duval County Court. The court did not address motions submitted showing discrimination.




Dear Honorable Judge Fryefield:


PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO STRIKE DEFENDANT'S ORDER

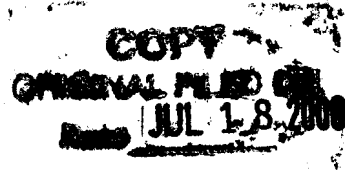

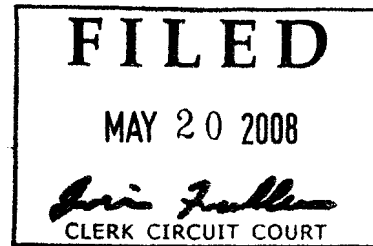

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court considers the Proposal.

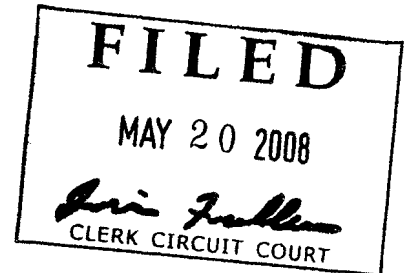

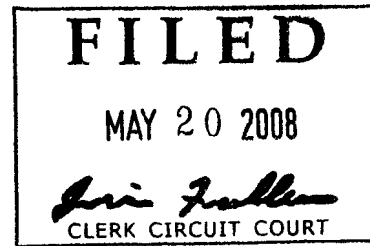

PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL

COMES NOW, the Plaintiff, Lillian Myhand, will respectfully make a second request for a jury trial, pursuant to Rules 1.430(a)(b)(c), Fla. R. Civ. P, and states as grounds for the trial:

1. The Plaintiff has contended all along that she was assaulted by Officer J.C. Nobles, Badge #7864 according to Section 784.001(1)(2), 784.021 (1)(a)(b) and 784.021(2) Florida Statutes.
2. The Defendant has said that the Plaintiff is crazy and she did not get hit I the head it is all I her mind, if she thinks she got hit her mind believes it really happened. Although, the Plaintiff spent thirty (30) hours in the hospital at Shands University Hospital, 580 West 8th Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32208 the night of the incident.
3. The Plaintiff feels that a jury trial is the only way to determine what happened that night and is ready for Officer Nobles to be cleared of her charge assault, and she will apologize for any miss givings that this has caused him.
4. The Plaintiff would like to know why her first request was ignored and would like to know why her Civil Right and Constitutional Rights are being ignored.

5. The Plaintiff would like for the Defendants to submit in writing the reason that her Rights are not being honored or at least tell her what Article, Rule of Civil or Criminal Procedure or what Constitution she may refer too in order to try to understand why she is being treated in this manner.
