

On 04/09/09 at approximately 2015 hours I was on duty in full uniform in a marked Tempe police patrol vehicle. I was in the vicinity of Southern and 48th St in Tempe when my attention was drawn to a White '97 Acura TL AZ/REALISM. I observed the vehicle heading Northbound on 48th St through the intersection with Southern. I was stationary on the South East corner of this intersection and ny attention was drawn to the vehicle due to the fact that it appeared to be travelling at a high rate of speed.

I entered the Northbound lanes of 48th St and started to follow the Acura Northbound along 48th St. We travelled North onto the State Route 143. The entire time I remained behind the vehicle with a clear and unobstructed view. As we travelled along the SR143 I entered the curb lane while the Acura remained in the through lane.

Approximately one mile South of the McDowell Rd exit where the freeway is 55 miles per hour I noted that the Acura appeared to be travelling at approximately 50 mph. I noted that there were three vehicles stacked up behind the Acura and could not pass. The road ahead was open and clear of traffic. The Acura was impeding the flow of traffic.

As we exited the freeway at Mcdowell Rd and headed Westbound into Phoenix I activated my overhead emergency lights indicating for the vehicle to stop. The vehicle pulled over and stopped in the curb lane of McDowell Rd outside #4350.

I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the open passenger side front window where I contacted three females who I now know as Serelda Millett (S), Latisha Morrow (S) and Taritha Neal (S).

I spoke to the driver, Serelda Millet, and asked to see her drivers license, insurance and registration. Millet gave me an Arizona Drivers License in the name of Ann Steiner . I explained why I had stopped her and then asked both Morrow and Neal for identification.

I told Millet, who at this point I believed to be Steiner, that I was not going to issue her a citation for impeding the flow of traffic, I told her she was being verbally warned and that she was free to leave. I then asked if she would consent to a search of the vehicle. Millet consented to a search. I directed Morrow and Neal to exit the vehicle and requested that they wait on the sidewalk with Millet while I performed the search.

While I was searching the vehicle I found a brown handbag on the front passenger seat where Morrow had been seated. Inside the handbag was a prescription bottle of medication in the name of Keith Thurston. Inside the bottle were two different styles of pills.

I continued to search the vehicle. In the back seat next to where Neal was seated was a handbag. Inside the handbag was a small black purse; in this I found one loose oval white pill with the markings M357.

i detained both Morrow and Neal placing them into handcuffs.

Tempe Police Officer D. Crites #18357 had arrived to assist me and he examined the pills and then contacted Banner Poison control center via telephone at 2100 hours where he spoke with Michelle. Officer Crites was advised that the single loose white oval pill in Neal's purse was a Vicadin which is a schedule 3 narcotic prescription only drug. There were four pills in the prescription bottle in Morrow's purse which were Oxycodone 5mg a schedule 2 narcotic prescription only drug. These Oxycodone pills were in a bottle marked for Lisinopril, a blood pressure medication.

At 2112 hours I arrested both Morrow and Neal for possession of narcotic drugs.

I then went back to speak with Millett. As I spoke with her I re-examined her drivers license. While looking more closely! noticed that the picture appeared to not exactly match. I asked Millet her date of birth (on the license I) stopped her and asked her what her real name. Millett then immediately told me her real name and explained that she had lied to me because her license is suspended. I asked her about the license and she told me it was her mothers who had died last year.

At 2117 hours l'arrested Millett for False information to law enforcement and driving on a suspended license. She made no reply.

The vehicle was towed and stored per ARS 28-3511 (IR 09-059751 refers). The work franchists and asked if the understand it.

I read Morrow her Mirenda Rights and asked if she understood them. She responded that she did and agreed to answer my questions. I asked her about the medication. She told me the following: Keith Thurston is the pastor of a church she belongs to and she was living with him and his wife for a while. Morrow said that she was in the process of moving out and had removed most of her belongings. While at her new apartment she realized that she had his prescription medication and planned on returning it. She claimed not to realize that there were two kinds of medication in there and stated that she knew nothing about the oxycodone (for full details refer to the impounded audio tape).

All three females were transported to the Tempe City Jail and Booked.

White at the Jail I spoke with Neal. I read her Miranda Rights to her and asked if she would answer my questions. Neal said that she understood her rights and agreed to answer the questions. I asked her about the Vicadin pill. Neal told me that she knew the pill was in her purse, that it was hers from a prescription from several months ago. I asked if she could prove this and she said that she did not keep the bottle and had no way of proving it to me (for full details refer to the impounded audio tape).

I then spoke with Millett. I read her Miranda Rights and asked if she understood them. Millett indicated that she did and agreed to answer my questions. I asked her about the AZ/DL she had given me. Millet told me that she knew she was suspended from driving and did not want to get arrested so she gave me her dead mothers driving license and claimed to be her to avoid the suspended license arrest (for full details refer to the impounded audio

cd of the interview).

Morrow was Booked on one count of possession of narcotic drugs per ARS 13-3408A1 and one count of possession of prescription only medication per ARS 13-3406A1. She was released pending on these charges but held on a parole violation.

Neal was Booked on one count of possession of narcotic drugs per ARS 13-3408A1 and one count of possession of drug paraphernalia per ARS 1303415A. She was released pending.

Millett was Booked on one count of false reporting to law enforcement per ARS 13-2907.01A and one count of driving on a suspended license per ARS 28-3473A. She was released pending.

Shortly after booking the subjects I spoke with Keith Thurston (M) via telephone. I asked Mr. Thurston about his prescription bottle of pills. He confirmed that he was the pastor of Morrow's church and that she had been living with his wife and him for some time but was in the process of moving out. He told me that he did have a prescription for lisinopril but that he does not take oxycodone and has no idea why four oxycodone tablets would be in his prescription bottle for lisinopril.

I impounded the four oxycodone pills, the vicadin pill, the purse the vicadin was in, the prescription bottle in Thurstons name and the AZ/DL as evidence at 8201 S. Hardy, locker #9.

No further information or evidence at this stage.
